

Your support of the Foundation Campaign *truly makes a difference* for our faculty and staff. Here's why:

Public education funding remains low.

- When adjusted for inflation, average teacher salaries have decreased by more than 5% in the past 10 years.*
- N.C. ranked 38th in the U.S. for teacher pay and 41st for per-pupil funding for the 2022-23 school year.*
- Wake County provides a salary increase for National Board Certified Teachers, which means many RCHS teachers are making 5-7% less teaching at RCHS than they would in the Wake County Public School System.
- Additionally, RCHS teachers are not part of the State Retirement plan.

RCHS teachers are high-qualified, experienced, and dedicated.

- 70% of RCHS teachers hold advanced degrees
- RCHS teachers have an average of 19 years of classroom experience
- More than half of our teachers have taught at RCHS for 15 years or more

Our faculty go above and beyond for our students. In addition to teaching, they...

- Advise many clubs and student organizations, including on nights and weekends
- Design and conduct Flex Day and Community Work Day programs
- Provide 1:1 support to students outside of class and school hours
- Write dozens of college recommendation letters each fall

Educators have an amazing impact on our students, our community, and our world.

- RCHS is a top ranking school with 400+ college acceptances and millions of dollars in college scholarships awarded to our graduates
- Our alumni work in a broad range of career fields across the globe and still return to RCHS to help our students
