

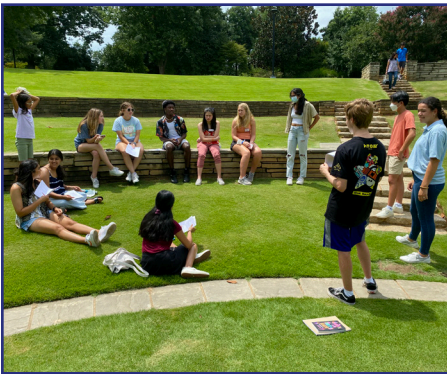

Each year, we ask our current families to contribute to the Phoenix Fund, our annual campaign for operational support. As a line item in our annual budget, donations supplement low per-pupil funding and make our day-to-day operations possible.

Our goal is to raise \$325,000 for the Phoenix Fund by March 31, 2023.

In addition to the annual Phoenix Fund, we have launched a multi-year initiative to ***secure the school for the future*** while also ***improving compensation for our incredible teachers.***

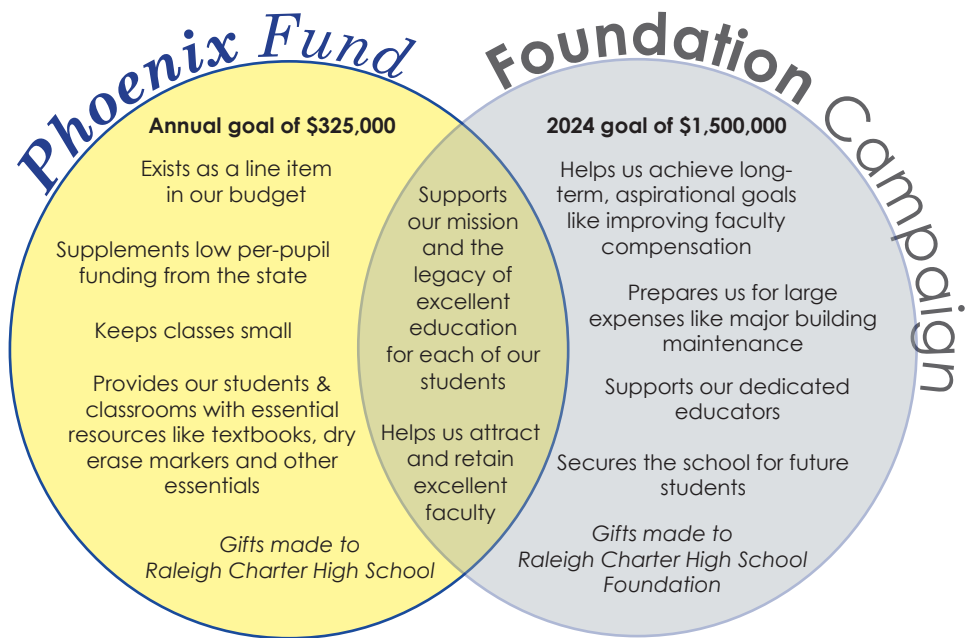
